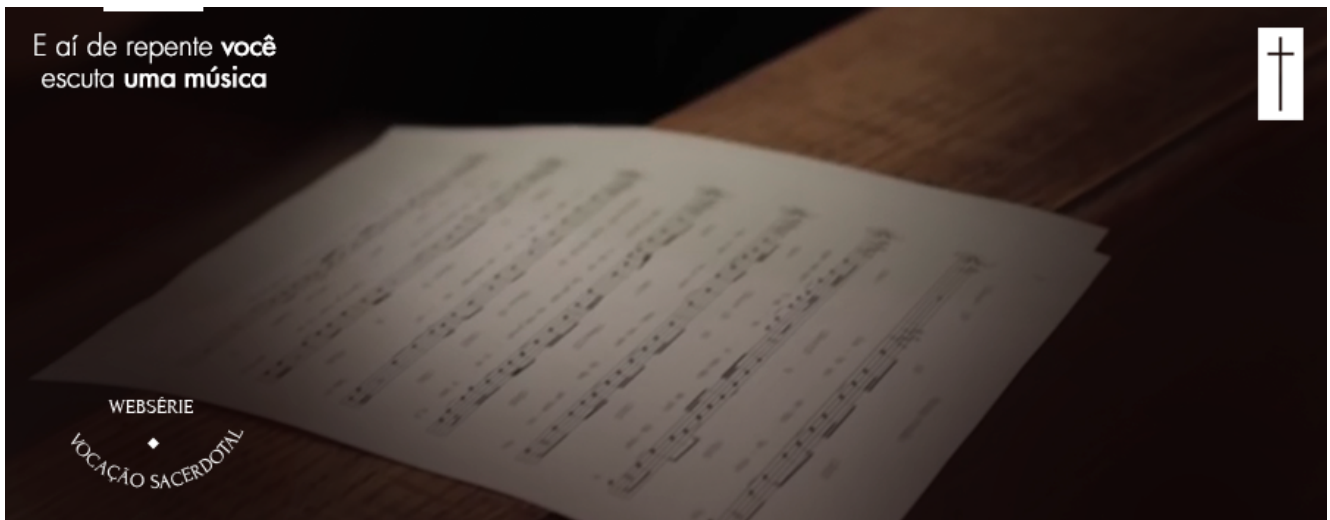


Priestly Vocation: And then suddenly you hear a song
